### 2020 Annual Report

The Gering Volunteer Fire Department is committed to protecting the people

and property of our community from hazards and emergencies through education, risk reduction and emergency response. The fire department met each challenge head on and was able to exceed performance expectations.

The department modified training and meetings and limited public education due to the national crisis. We found creative ways to continue to provide essential services and trainings while mitigating COVID risks. We documented 4,030 man hours of training and 2,460 hours of activities.


7 members obtained Fire 1 Instructor certification which extended their professional development. 3 members attended and Incident Command/Division Supervisor classes and are working towards credentialing. Firefighters also attended leadership training, Engine Boss Qualification class, Firefighter 2 and attend weekly drills on various trainings.

Firefighters from Gering spent 33 days in Colorado, Idaho and South Dakota on large wildfires. This hard work is because of a contract with the Nebraska Forest Service. Gering FD is the only department in Nebraska that has this type of contract and our governing boards see revenue associated with these assignments. Because of our commitment, Gering FD was awarded the Nebraska State Forester Award in 2020.

Gering FD was called to standy by during the Street Outlaws filming south of Gering. Firefighters spent 17 nights, totaling 130 hours. We billed \$18,130 in total services.

Chris Perales received the Fire Department's "LeRoy Elliott" Firefighter of the Year. Jim Lawson was elected as Secretary-Treasurer of the Scotts Bluff County Mutual Aid. Darrell Vance was elected as the 2nd Vice President of the Nebraska State Volunteer Firefighters Association (the 7th firefighter from Gering to hold this office).

This is the 20th year of the Mutual Finance Assistance Fund from the state of Nebraska. The city received \$45,421 and the Rural received \$22,264. The department also received 3 grants totaling \$36,400 to be used towards PPE, training and replacement of fire prevention equipment.



On behalf of the Fire Department, I would like to thank President Heimbouch and Rural Board for heir continued support and cooperation given to us throughout the year.

### NFS AGREEMENT

In 2019 Gering Fire became a Nebraska State Cooperator through a negotiated contract. This allows members of our department to support out of state federal fires as a Nebraska resource.

Members spend time on large incidents and gain incredible knowledge to bring back home. Firefighters continue to develop through their careers and that knowledge gained supports our local fires.

The program also generates additional revenue for GFD.

We are the only department in Nebraska that was offered this opportunity.

### 2020 STATE FORESTER AWARD

Gering fire was notified in May that we were the recipient of the 2020 Nebraska State Forester Award. This prestigous award is given to individuals and agencies that support and commit to enhancing Nebraska's forest resources. The award is given once per year from Nebraska Forester John Erixson.

Mr. Erixson stated "It is the strong leadership Gering Fire provides that gives us a chance to keep fires small here in Nebraska. It is truly my honor to recognize your team for providing this leadership for all of us. Gering Fire have lead the way in innovation through your creativity in developing the Engine Academy and working through challenges to become a Nebraska Wildfire Resource..."

The recipient is usually recognized during a ceremony in front of the Unicameral. Unfortunately this year events were cancelled.

We are appreciative and very humbled to be recognized to this degree.



### R STREET FIRE

In December Gering Fire was dispatched to a residential fire on R Street.

Firefighter immediately began search and rescue operations and encountered heavy smoke, extreme heat and structural damage. Additional firefighters made entry into the home and experienced a flashover, where an entire room caught fire.

Once fire was knocked down firefighters located the resident in the bedroom. There has not been a firefighter fatality in Gering since prior to the 1950's.

NE State Fire Marshal was called to investigate, and determined the fire was caused by smoking materials.

### YEARLY INCIDENT STATISTICS

2020 seen 794 calls for service, an increase from last year by 85. We seen a dip in calls in March when the COVID outbreak began. We also seen a large increase in fires, a nationwide trend when the nation began a lockdown. We logged 76 fires, the most in a year. 577 were deemed Rescue or EMS calls. We also spent 5 total days on the Hubbard Gap Fire in August.

20%, or 164 calls overlapped. Multiple apparatus responded during the same time period to manage multiple incidents. Overlapping events are worrisome for our staffing model, and overlap increased by 8% in 2020. Our average response for all types of calls was approximately  $7\,1/2$  minutes. We were 96% compliant against an 8 minute response value.

We spent an average of 103 minutes on scene of all emergencies, largely in part to several prolonged events. EMS calls tend to see an average of 25 minutes on scene. We provided mutual aid 40 times to area fire departments.

Our busiest times is on Thursday at 2:00 pm. Our busiest hour was between 5:00 pm and 6:00 pm. July was a record month with 90 calls.

We seen a large fire loss this year due to a record number of fires. Property involved in fire amounts to \$9,777,942 with an estimated \$618,450 loss.





### INFECTIOUS CONTROL

Our Infectious Control Plan is reviewed annually. In 2020 we spent over 20 hours reviewing and modifying our training.

Our department was the first in the county to implement fit testing procedures for special N95 masks and followed strict guidelines after many trainings on proper use of EMS PPE.

Firefighters bought into the training and updated guidelines and used gowns, masks, gloves and special shields on every EMS call. And it paid off.

We had zero cases of COVID traced back to our department or patients we assisted.

### TRAINING STATISTICS

Gering Fire Department logged 4,030 man-hours of training in 2020. Training occurs at a minimum of once a week and more often 5 times per month. Majority of our training is dedicated to firefighting and EMS in order to achieve proper ISO ratings.

We did implement modifications to our training programs this year, but held majority of our exercises in person. For months the focus was on mission critical evolutions and delayed several of our normal inter agency trainings. We did have 7 members obtain Instructor after a 48 hour course held in house. 3 firefighters obtained Firefighter 2 after a 36 hour training course.

This is our 3rd year hosting the Nebraska Engine Academy. The 3 day exercise brought over 200 firefighters to Gering to participate and learn how to manage a large scale emergency. This was the first year we brought several Nebraska Army National Guard helicopters to our area. The exercise is intended to develop our firefighters and is not held anywhere else in the country. Due to this style of training, we were able to minimize the impact to our community and loss from fire on the Hubbard Gap Fire.

### LEROY ELLIOTT FIRE-FIGHTER OF THE YEAR

Leroy Elliott was a firefighter for Gering Fire Department for almost 50 years. Every year he was one of the top responders even in his 70's. Leroy represented what it meant to be a top firefighter.

In 2020, Chris Perales was awarded this award. He accumulated over 258 hours of training and activities and responded to 529 calls. Chris joined our department in 2018 after—serving with two other local—departments. He is already certified as a Firefighter 1 and has maintained his credentials.

### PERSONNEL STATISTICS

People are our number one asset in any organization. Gering Fire Department supports our firefighters and invests in their career at the department. In 2020 we logged over 1,033 hours of regional, state and local meetings. Because our staff is invaluable, we could never put a cost savings number on our response.

Our roster includes 39 firefighters and 2 Cadets. Our Department implemented a Cadet Program that introduces high school seniors to the fire service. Within two years we have seen 17 kids attend fire department trainings and events. We have been able to retain 5 of those Cadets that are currently full members.

As mentioned earlier, Chris Perales received the Firefighter of the Year Award. Darrell Vance holds 2nd Vice President of the Nebraska State Volunteer Firefighters Association. Andrew Lehr was recognized for 5 years of service and Tom Modena has served the citizens of Gering for 25 years.

31 out of 29 members qualified for the City of Gering Incentive Program. This program continues to be instrumental in retaining members.

### FIRE PUP PROGRAM

Gering Fire teams up with Scottsbluff Fire and the National Fire Safety Council to fund fire prevention material. We have participated in this program for over 20 years.

NFSC manages the program and solicits local businesses to assist in making fire prevention supplies like coloring books, helmets and booklets.

Local businesses donate an average of \$8,000 each year to fund much needed supplies. Both fire departments utilize these supplies throughout the year.

This program saves each city thousands a year. We couldn't do it without local support.

### FIRE PREVENTION AND PUBLIC RELATIONS

2020 was challenging for fire prevention. We cancelled our Junior Fire Patrol Program when schools cancelled and limited entry into the station due to COVID concerns. Still, through multiple online media platforms we were able to reach thousands with several fire prevention tips. Even with events being cancelled, we were able to log 1,427 manhours on education and public relations.

Last October we worked with schools and followed guidelines to enter and present education programs. We came in contact with an estimated 250 kids and taught various ways to prevent fire.

Our fire prevention material is paid for through donations from local businesses. National Fire Safety Council develops a program that solicits local businesses. We partner with Scottsbluff Fire Department and have been extremely successful with this program. In 2020 local businesses raised \$8,430 to fund all material.

As mentioned earlier, we spent 17 nights on detail while Street Outlaws filming took place. Additionally, we partnered with area fire departments to staff a mobile unit to respond to community needs in November and December. We logged over 7 12 hour shifts which re-

duced the stress on our ambulance services.


