GENERAL PURPOSE

Performs skilled and semi-skilled work in the operation, maintenance and compliance of the Wastewater Treatment Plant, wastewater pump stations, water production wells and water pump stations.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED

Works under the direct supervision of the Public Works Director.

SUPERVISION EXERCISED

May supervise individuals and a small crew in the operation and preventative maintenance of the Wastewater Treatment Plant, wastewater pump stations water production wells and water pump stations.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Operates the Wastewater Treatment Plant within the requirements of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit, (NPDES)

Completes necessary reports and recordkeeping for local, State and Federal regulatory agencies.

Programs and sets wastewater samplers.

Collects samples and performs routine laboratory tests on water, wastewater facilities and enters results in the computer.

Performs industrial and domestic pre-treatment sampling, testing, readings and reporting.

Inspects and read flow meters and water level gauges.

Records and calculates daily flows and loadings for the Wastewater Treatment Plant and pump stations.

Records and calculates daily flows for the water production, water pumping facilities and chemical feed equipment.

Performs preventive maintenance and repairs on pump stations, sewer mains, pumps and all other equipment connected with the wastewater treatment, collection, water production and water pumping systems.

Maintains an inventory, inspects, and develops a schedule for the cleaning of mud, oil separators and grease traps.

Routinely performs tests and operates standby generators.

Performs general maintenance work on facility buildings and grounds including fence repair, mowing and weed control.

Operates trucks and medium equipment such as backhoes, loaders, sewer jets and tractors.

Utilizes SCADA system that controls and monitors the operations of water and wastewater systems.

Assists in the preparation and implementation of the operational and capital budget for the department.

Oversees the computation of billing for industrial waste.

Performs inventory control and replacement of parts.

Assists with training employees in the maintenance work for the Wastewater Treatment Plant, wastewater collection system, water production wells, wastewater pumping and water pumping facilities.

Responds to after-hours service and emergency calls.

Occasionally repairs vehicles, equipment, buildings, concrete and asphalt.

Performs any other duties as assigned.

PERIPHERAL DUTIES

Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with employees, other utilities and the public.

DESIRED MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Education and Experience

- A. Any combination of experience and training equivalent to completion of the twelfth grade.
- B. Three years of experience in water and wastewater system operations and maintenance.

- C. Three years of experience in the operation and maintenance of a wastewater treatment plant.

- A. Knowledge of the principals, practices and methods related to the operating procedures related to water production, distribution and pumping facilities.
- B. Knowledge of the principals, practices, methods, treatment processes and operating procedures related to an advance wastewater treatment plant, collection system and pumping stations.
- C. Ability to organize and to lead a crew of one to three employees.
- D. Ability to perform routine water and wastewater laboratory tests.
- E. Knowledge of water and wastewater safety practices.
- F. Knowledge of State and Federal water and wastewater standards.
- G. Knowledge of instrumentation for plant monitoring and control.
- H. Knowledge of methods, materials, tools and equipment used in the construction, operation, maintenance and repair of wastewater and water systems.
- I. Ability to establish, adjust and monitor the SCADA control system.
- J. Ability to oversee the maintenance of equipment.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

The physical demands require good physical condition and ability to perform hard labor for extended periods of time and the ability to perform moderate to heavy physical work and to lift 75 pounds, to lift and carry 50 pounds and occasionally 100 pounds.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is frequently required to stand, walk, sit, ride, bend, climb, crawl, twist, kneel, reach, grasp, pick, pinch, push, pull and perform a variety of similar body movements. Also, the ability to talk and hear in person, by telephone and w-way radio; ability to see and read instructions, maps, location sketches, similar document and a computer screen. The employee must possess hand, eye and foot coordination adequate to use hand and power tools and operate a vehicle and equipment.
